

**Report to CIO's  
November 16, 2017  
Kim Harrell, Liaison to  
California Community Colleges Curriculum Committee (5C)**

The committee met November 16, 2017 from 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM in the Chancellor's Office Room. The agenda and approved minutes from the last meeting (October 19, 2017) are attached in the e-mail accompanying this report.

**Meeting dates for 2017- 2018:** December 15, January 26, 2018, February 15, March 16, April 20, May 17, and June 7.

**Urgent updates / items for discussion**

**1. Non-credit Curriculum Streamlining-** 5C proposed starting with Career Development and College Prep (CDCP) courses as a pilot for curriculum streamlining for non-credit. The first step will be to collect the Title 5 and Education Code sections related to non-credit. Knowing the volume of courses likely to be submitted, the Chancellor's Office (CO) is expanding from one non-credit reviewer to three. 5C recommended developing a non-credit FAQ and updating the "Non-credit at a Glance" publication. The field is encouraged to participate in the first Friday webinars by Association of Community and Continuing Education (ACCE). There will be a joint conference of the Academic Senate, CTE, and ACCE in May.

**2. Executive Orders 1100 and 1110 –** The Early Assessment Program (EAP) will be ending as per 1110. Accuplacer is coming off the approved list and standards under which it was approved won't be the same as those to assess the next generation of Accuplacer. It is unclear at present, but there may be no CO approved assessment tests going forward.

**3. AB 705 –** The CO is working with the California Department of Education to get a data-sharing agreement. There are certain fields that must be turned on in CCC Apply to get the data.

**Three big takeaways**

1. The UC Transfer Pathway (UCTP) pilot is on hold until the UC's choose to accept these degrees. The MOU from the CO is with the UC Regents.
2. The CO will issue a legal opinion regarding online catalogs. Online catalog guidelines will be made available by the Curriculum Institute this summer.
3. COCI improvement are continuously being made. A detailed COCI status update is attached with this report.
