Charter and Membership review

- Noted that faculty representation is extremely important. Voting membership will include 5 faculty members, CIO, CSSO, CEO, ACCE, SCCCC, 2 CCCCCO (Dean of Basic Skills and VC Educational Services).

Curriculum Institute update

- There will be a session designed for part-time faculty on how to secure a full time job. Will include mock interview exercise.

Legislative discussion

- AB 705 – ESL – More information from the CCCCCO within next couple of weeks. Concern expressed about future of testing and writing samples. Also, only 25% have HS transcripts
- 1935 (Irvin)/1009 (Wilks) – Senate more favorable to Wilks as it adds student initiated and Basic Skills. The two will likely be merged according to Alice P.

Budget Funding Formula

- Reviewed with some discussion

Basic Skills Grants

- BSSOT - More time to spend the second level of allocations (the 60 M)
- Partnership grants - will be extended to June 30, 2019 with reports due August 2018
