Sorry for the delay in getting these results back to you. In December, I asked the following question over the listserv:

We are having a conversation on campus. Which describes your planned use of the new zero-cost icon [SB 1359, to be required starting January 1, 2018]?

1. Are you putting it on ANY section with zero cost?
2. Are you putting it on only those sections that are SUPPOSED to have a cost but don't because of the adoption of open educational resources?

Here are the results:

- Colleges opting for 1 7
- Colleges opting for 2 1
- Colleges opting for 2 but still discussing it 1

So all that was greatly appreciated, but the question pretty much became a settled matter (for option 1) when LeBaron weighed in: "The language does not specify that the materials have to be OER but states the following "may" component that is highlighted below. The association with OER is not the focus. The focus is "free" to the student which may or not be OER."
