Committee Charge:

The Commission on Athletics has been developed to promote and ensure academic progress, amateurism, ethical conduct, and equitable competition for student athletes. Institutional self compliance is essential to the achievement of the educational goals of the intercollegiate athletics programs.

Meeting Topics:

1. The Association has been working with the NCAA in an attempt to revise the two-year transfer policy; to provide a year of academic readiness for those student athletes who by NCAA standards are considered nonqualifiers and are considered in need of remediation. The proposal has now been put in legislative form.
2. The Academic and Athletic Standards Review Committee (AASRC) has been working for several years in an attempt to develop an academic performance report. The Committee has worked with Cal-PASS to identify the project scope and parameters for the academic performance study. Additional reports and studies, such as the League's Commission on the Future and the CCC Student Success Task Force, are useful examples in showing how the CCC students have performed and identifying future goals.
3. The Policy Committee Chair Dale Murray reported that the Committee will try to work with the conference commissioners to schedule program reviews to be held concurrently with the accreditation.

Topics for CCCCCIO consideration/discussion:

The CCCCCIO membership should strongly consider taking progressive action by reducing the repeatability of physical education classes and further reducing costs of athletics.
