CMP enhances teachers' mathematical content knowledge and pedagogical content knowledge that is aligned to the *California Mathematics Standards and Framework*.

**Meeting Agenda Topics:**

The meeting was a site visit to SDSU to evaluate a teacher summer institute for CSET review. Participants were instructed by a SDSU math faculty on algebra, geometry, and probability and statistics topics, in preparation for the CSET exam.
