**Committee Charge:**

**Provide guidance to colleges on CTE min quals and the equivalency process in an effort to meet the needs to hire CTE faculty.**

**Meeting Agenda Topics:**

**Outcomes from today's meeting:**

- 1. White paper with timelines and goals will go out from Pam and Julie Bruno in January**
- 2. State wide Senate will bring CTE discipline faculty together with industry experts to discuss CTE min quals and equivalency options.**
- 3. Advisory group will consider the long standing (from AB1725) "AA plus 6 and BA plus 2" knowing that many disciplines change very quickly. And industry experts have expertise in the field but need teaching guidance and mentoring.**
- 4. Could there be sub-disciplines or one course equivalencies?**
- 5. Could there be provisional hiring of CTE faculty – meaning they are hired with the provision that in x time they will obtain an AA degree. Need to bring faculty unions into this conversation.**

**Topics for CCCCCIO consideration/discussion:**

**Kathie put out an email to the CIO listserv to ask for the disciplines CIOs are having difficulty finding faculty to fill. The Senate/Industry expert group will consider the top ten most difficult fields first.**
