Committee Charge:

To implement Student Success Task Force Recommendation 1.1 by providing a forum for representatives from California Community Colleges key stakeholder groups to understand national and state efforts to implement the new Common Core State Standards and accompanying K-12 assessments planned for 2014-15 and to provide input on CCC alignment with K-12, definitions of college and career readiness, and transition of the Early Assessment Program.

Meeting Agenda Topics:

- Common Core Transition Plan and Legislative Update
 - Deborah Sigman, Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction, CDE
 - Encourage faculty to review the practice tests
 - There will be an Open Source Standard Setting Session based on the results of the Spring 2014 field tests
- Early Assessment Program (EAP) Transition
 - Carolina Cardenas, Director, Academic Outreach/EAP, CSU CO
 - 2014 – students wanting to take EAP must take full CST; only receive EAP results
 - UC and CSU are planning on aligning with Smarter Balanced ALDs as indicators for student placement and there is a focus on aligning curriculum
- Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) Update and Career Readiness Definition Report
 - Jacqueline King and Jane Wellman, SBAC
 - College Readiness – means student is ready for entry-level, transferable, credit bearing course
 - Approach to Career Readiness is focused on creating customizable score interpretation resources; recognize ‘careers’ vs. ‘jobs’ require some postsecondary education or training
 - Career Readiness Framework linked to Exemplar Occupations is available for review and comment; need to distribute
- National Governor’s Association (NGA) Grant to Engage Higher Education in Common Core Implementation
 - Camille Esch, Consultant, Project Manager
 - The focus for the grant is development of a state plan that articulates how the California higher education system will support the statewide transition to Common Core Standards in three areas: teacher development, assessment, and undergraduate education.
 - Managed by SBOE and CA Education Round Table Intersegmental

Coordinating Committee with steering team members from DOE, Legislature, CCC, CSU, UC, AICCU and CA Commission on Teacher Credentialing

- Communication Plan and Next Steps
 - Develop short PP for communication on Common Core
 - Work on curriculum transition and alignment
 - ASCCC appoint English and Math
 - Webinar on CC, standards, assessments, etc.
