To provide direction for CCC Assess development, implementation and PD.

Meeting Agenda Topics:

1) Delay in implementation of the CCC Assess tool – went over the executive summary response from CCC Assessment Workgroup. See info at this link:

- seeking provisional approval, with requirements to submit additional information
- braille accommodations for the CCC Assess will be dependent on the paper/pencil version.
- Still moving forward with releases this fall so that schools can test their systems and processes.

2) Alternatives to Compass –

- Locally stored software
- other approved instruments
- delay to assessment cycles
- new basecamp for sharing ideas and resources
- don't use a test and use two other measures

Chancellor's office is working on an agreement with COMPASS to continue

support for the 32 colleges that are using COMPASS and slated to implement in fall 2016.

Chancellor office will send out notice to the Presidents, CIO, CSSO, SSSP coordinator and assessment reps of the 32 schools on COMPASS regarding pricing and potential for support for the Spring 2017 admission/ registration cycle. Keep an eye out for this information.

3) Presentation on the placement model was provided. We have chosen to utilize the Rasch model to determine the student's placement. Will try to get the link to the presentation so CIOs are aware of the placement mechanism that is developed.

Topics for CCCIO consideration/discussion:

If you are one of the 32 schools, keep an eye out for Chancellor's office correspondence regarding COMPASS. If your school is using a locally stored COMPASS set-up or has access to paper/pencil, you can use. Otherwise, consider other means. Shared with the CAI steering group and Chancellor's office the need for quick attention to this matter since it will impact new student enrollments for spring 2017.

Chancellor office is refining a memo to send out to the colleges to clarify the memo that was sent 8/2/16 regarding multiple measures. Memo will clarify that the use of GPA and grade in last English/math course as two separate measures and is allowable according to the regs. However, this means of placement will not be applicable to all student groups.

Also, Accuplacer approval has been extended to July 2017.
