**Committee Charge:**

The Intersegmental Curriculum Workgroup (ICW) is composed of representatives from CCC and CSUS Academic Senates; counselors and transfer/articulation centers; CCC and CSU Chancellor's office representatives; ASCCC staff; and 1 administrator from CCC. The group serves as the curriculum workgroup for the implementation of SB 1440 degrees.

**Meeting Agenda Topics:**

TMC Policies and Processes

- TMCs for other languages – proposed using modified TMC process based on Spanish to generate TMCs for other foreign languages which have in total small numbers of students; revisit next meeting
- Model Curriculum Policy – document was approved for posting
- Guarantees for High-Unit degrees – outcome will be dependent on the discipline and may or may include the guarantees that come with 1440
- ICW Statement on GE Component of ADT – document was approved for posting

IGETC for STEM Implementation – draft documents were presented for review  
Discipline Updates and Discussion

- Biology ready to vetting; A&P courses are being assigned to reviewers
- Pulling several FDRGs together; new lead for Kinesiology

Areas of Emphasis – working document defining “areas of emphasis” was adopted

- Social Science - postponed to next agenda
- Ethnic Studies -- recommend pulling together a DIG including faculty from Asian-American, African-American, Chicano-American studies programs to initiate discussion

Reports

- Senate Updates focused on development of areas of emphasis – no updates from ASCCC; CSU passed resolution urging exemption for Engineering unit max
- ICO Report – no report
- CCCCCO Report
  - 1078 degrees approved; 595 in process
  - Chancellor Harris has contacted 30 presidents over the last few

weeks to discuss progress towards degrees

- Overtures from UC and private colleges (AICCU) regarding TMC
- 18,000 CSU applicants indicated they were pursuing ADT
- CSU CO Report – provided updated list of CSU-TMC alignment
- Draft MOU between CSU and CCC for implementation of SB1440 – a draft document was distributed for review

- Budget document

Local TMC Development Conversation – proposal to develop a simplified process for use at local level will be continued at future meeting
