Issue

Chancellor's Office staff will provide an update on implementation of several Student Success Task Force proposals.

Background

In January, 2012, the California Community Colleges Board of Governors endorsed the recommendations of the Student Success Task Force. As we move forward with implementation, the Chancellor's Office will be providing regular updates to the Consultation Council.

At this month's meeting, we will present the following items:

Student Success Act of 2012

- Recommendation 8.2: Invest in a student support initiative. (see attached summary and bill language which are identical to the versions sent to the Council on February 2)
- Recommendation 3.2: Require students receiving Board of Governors Fee Waivers to meet various conditions. (see attached summary and bill language which are identical to the versions sent to the Council on February 2)

Other Proposals

- Recommendation 7.1: The state should develop and support a strong community college system office.
- Recommendation 1.1: Community colleges will collaborate with K-12 education to jointly develop new common standards for college and career readiness that are aligned with high school exit standards. (see attached action plan)
- Recommendation 7.3: Implement a student success scorecard. (see attached action plan)
