5. Anything thing else that you think would be good for me to know regarding senate funding.

Antelope Valley	AS President has 60% reassigned time
Barstow	The senate president gets release time and \$200 for “supplies”.
Chaffey	Senate president gets 70% release time. The Senate budget also has money to cover their annual membership dues. Membership dues vary from year to year; for our college it typically ranges from \$3,500 to \$4,000.
College of the Redwoods	Professional growth funding is separate. In addition they receive 1.13 FTE in reassigned time.
El Camino	Keep a tight rein.
Fullerton College	AS president gets 80% reassigned time
Gavilan	Office of instruction will periodically provide additional dollars if appropriate when the Senate uses all of the allocated funds. Individual faculty can also apply for funds through the Faculty and Staff Development Committee to attend Senate events.
Hancock	1.4 FTE release time for AS officers
Mt SAC	reassigned time for Senate leadership - the president has 100%, the vice president has 80%, and the secretary has 20%.
Reedley	Release time for Senate president, and other officers, total 1.5 FTE
Rio Hondo	Senate president gets 80% release time
San Bernardino Valley	AS president gets 63% release time
Taft	The Senate leadership determines who travels and how they spend the funds
