Committee Charge:

The Telecommunications and Technology Advisory Committee (TTAC) advises the California Community Colleges (CCC) Chancellor's Office on the continued development and deployment of telecommunications and educational technologies in the California Community Colleges. The Committee researches technology trends and recommends the direction for technology infrastructure initiatives within California Community College system.

Topics for CCCCCIO consideration/discussion:

- 1. Budget Change Proposal for 2013-14 was submitted to request funding for Centralized Assessment, Educational Planning Tools, Professional Development, and Common Learning Management System.**
- 2. The Chancellor's Office continues to work with CENIC on broadband connectivity at CCCs in different regions.**
- 3. There is an eTranscript mini-grant to help CCCs get on board**

- eTranscript which already includes all UC campuses and 19 out of 23 CSU campuses (though no K-12 schools). All CCCs are expected to be on board by June 30, 2013.**
- 4. SB 1456 (Student Success Initiative) and SB 1052&1053 (sTextbook) were signed by Governor Brown.**
 - 5. A Cal-PASS grant was awarded to San Joaquin Delta CCD.**
 - 6. Significant work has been done expanding the C-ID system, aiming at smooth transfer and articulation among California higher education institutions. Relevant information can be found at www.c-id.net.**
 - 7. The Chancellor's Office expects to use the multi-million Central California Community Colleges Committed to Change (C6) consortium project as a pilot for statewide common assessment.**
 - 8. The Data Warehouse project team plans to conduct predictive analysis using the Cal-PASS, EAP, CCCApply, and CCCCO MIS data.**
 - 9. The Foundation for CCCs is awarded a Kresge grant to develop the CCC Student Portal to provide student information and help them complete their educational goals.**
 - 10. The Chancellor's Office is looking at ways to expand distance education offering to CCC students.**
 - 11. OpenCCC and OpenCCCApply are developed to support statewide student services and data sharing.**
 - 12. The Systemwide Architecture Committee proposes to hire a Chief Information Security Officer at the CCC Technology Center to oversee the Desktop Virtualization project. The position is already in the budget.**
