Committee Charge:

To provide direction for CCC Common Assessment development, implementation and PD.

Meeting Agenda Topics:

1) Placement model:

- Based on competency mapping being done by faculty
- Student performance connected to the competency mapping
- Determination of mastery or not based on the student performance
- Placement recommendation based on the courses within a CB21 level and its connection to the mapping done
- Transfer of the recommendation to the local Student Info System
- Universal adaptor (Project Glue) to provide placement recommendations to students.

2) RFP will be released to address:

- Writing sample development
- Assessment Prep

3) MMAP and integration into the Common Assessment tool.

- Project is working to incorporate the MMAP criteria into the tool.

Topics for CCCCIO consideration/discussion:

Phasing of implementation – different features provided from the project will be available in phases – What are the implications?

- Common Assessment
 - Multiple-choice adaptive test
 - Writing samples
 - ESL Listening
- Multiple Measures Project criteria
- Reports (counselor, student, faculty, administrators)
- Data warehouse integration

Policy implications – Since the scores are portable, CIOs should consider the policy implications for students coming in with scores from tests taken at other schools.

Writing sample RFP is going to go out and representation from CCCCIO would be good to have so that we are aware of the writing sample test development.

IEPI is offering up to \$75,000 for assistance with implementing alternate options given that the Common Assessment is delayed.
